The Feast of Divine Mercy is this Sunday, April 8. Everyone is invited to gather at St. Boniface Church from 3:00-4:00 pm for our Divine Mercy Holy Hour. Bring your rosary and we will pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy first and then I will hear confessions. Eucharistic Adoration will be held the entire hour, with Benediction at 4:00 pm. I will continue confessions after 4:00 if need be. Thank you to the Karen Eischeid Family for what they do to bring this to us each year. In case you are not familiar with Divine Mercy Sunday, it was started by Saint Pope John Paul II in the Jubilee Year 2000, just after the canonization of St. Faustina. As an application of the mercy Jesus won through his Passion, Death and Resurrection, the Church offers the opportunity for us to receive a plenary indulgence on Divine Mercy Sunday. An indulgence removes the effects of sin that are left over after those sins have been confessed and forgiven. To receive the Divine Mercy plenary indulgence one needs to: 1) Go to confession sometime within 20 days; 2) receive Communion; 3) pray for the Pope; 4) and take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy (in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for sin).

I hope to see many ladies come out for our special Christian Mothers Mass and Induction Tuesday evening.
